




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Executive Summary





Figure 1: Example of SAP Build Process Automation


Achieve predictable, reliable supply chains

Reduce errors



Purchase Requisitions Approval in SAP Ariba Solutions

Situation

Employees and department managers within any organization often need new supplies, equipment, training, and more. As such, they generate large numbers of purchase-requisition requests for procurement specialists to manually verify. This isn't just a tedious process – it also slows your organization down when employees and departmental managers don't have the supplies necessary to do their jobs. To achieve greater business agility, procurement professionals need a solution to help them automate the approval of purchase requisitions.

Solution

When a purchase requisition requiring an external approval is received from an SAP Ariba solution, a pre-configured process variant is triggered in SAP Build Process Automation based on defined business conditions. The approvers are determined based on the requisitions data with the help of business rules. The purchase requisition is either approved or rejected before the document is updated in the SAP Ariba solution.




Figure 2: Process Flow for Automating the Approval of Purchase Requisitions from SAP Ariba Solutions

Real-Time Visibility into the Operations of SAP Ariba Procurement Solutions




Figure 3: Real-Time Visibility Dashboard for Operations in SAP Ariba Procurement Solutions

This package provides flexibility in automating the granular process steps to capture and validate general vendor, accounting, and purchasing data while obtaining respective approvals.




Figure 4: Process Flow for Automating Vendor Onboarding in SAP S/4HANA





Figure 5: Process Flow for Automating and Maintaining Purchase Information Records
